Hobia received her B.A. in Sociocultural Cultural Anthropology and Ethnicity & Race Studies from Columbia University as well as a M.A. and M.Ed. in Curriculum & Instruction from University of Texas at Austin with a graduate portfolio in Native American & Indigenous Studies. In the midst of completing her degrees, Lakota began living and working in Oklahoma for her Tribal Nation, Citizen Potawatomi Nation, in 2011. Upon completing her graduate degree, she has worked at the Citizen Potawatomi Nation, Nottawaseppi Huron Band of the Potawatomi, and now currently the Match-E-Be-Nash-She-Wish Band of Pottawatomi Indians.
